FIGHTING FOR POWER

During the first round of the CIK/FIA European Championship, the first important meeting of the season, VM Motor Racing lines up in KZ2 to match their skill with the best manufacturers in the world.

Placing their engines in the hands of Adam Janous, Sander Kemna, Barry de Boorder and Judith Van der Linde. Always fighting mid-field, Janous proves to be VM Motor standard-bearer. He qualifies with the best 34 for the final test and manages to stand out of the 94 grids. Making the most of his VM engine, the Czech driver is constant in Race 1 as he attacks his rivals coming up 18 places in the 21-lap race: great!

After getting row nine grid start for the final, Adam is involved in an accident on lap one that removes his chances of fighting for leading points in the European Championship.

The next meeting is on June 29th in Mariembourg, where VM Motor Racing will be lining up for the second round of the Cik/Fia European Championship.
