



LOOKING AHEAD TO MARIEMBOURG

VM Motor Racing is ready to line up its top driver Adam Janous in the European KZ2 Championship round 2, to be held on 26/29th June in Mariembourg (B).

After marking some fast laps and finishing 18th in Race 1 – up 16 places from starting grid - at the European Championship round 1, the Czech driver has prepared relentlessly, getting more and more confident with his equipment. Round 4 of the WSK, held on 8th June at Mariembourg, was a good training ground to get useful feedback and experience on the very technical Belgian circuit - though the bad weather conditions compromised Adam's performance in the Qualifying and Heat sessions. The Czech driver, strong of two wins and a 2nd in Czech KZ2 Championship, looks forward with optimism to the forthcoming European event. 'I'm ready to pull off a great performance, as I'll be supported by top material. I'm very confident and I hope to score valuable points for the championship' says Adam.

On his side powered by VM engines, the four drivers of Dutch team Karting Paradise, are ready to race their boots off to beat the fierce competition. The two beautiful lady drivers, Priscilla Speelman and Judith Van der Linde, will take on the grids with Sander Kemma and Barry De Boorder at Mariembourg Karting des Fagnes fantastic circuit.
