VM MOTOR GROWING AND LOOKS TO 2009

The exciting racing season that has seen VM Motor racing officially in the most important international event, the CIK-FIA European Championship, ended with the third round of the KZ2 class, which was held on the French circuit in Varennes sur Allier. Confirming once again their winning partnership with MS Kart, as in the previous Angerville and Mariembourg rounds. VM Motor has confirmed its trust in Adam Janous, who has been outstanding on this occasion, as its official driver. During qualifying heats, where 59 drivers fought hard for a place in two last finals, Adam took a very good 11th in first race and confirmed his skill taking fourth in heat three. Unfortunately, despite his brilliant performance in two out of the four heats, the championship's fate was compromised by bad luck that made Adam drop back for the remaining two heats, excluding him from the final phases of the event. Adam Janous: "Despite bad luck, this time too, my kart was up to expectations. Our engine wasn't second to anyone else's, on the contrary, it often allowed me to gain on my rivals thanks to good acceleration, and the heat results are proof enough." Also the next CIK-FIA European Championship will be seeing VM Racing, after many requests from their customers, is ready to put very competitive official drivers on grids for the 2009 season.
