In the first heat, Janouš and Hájek fought their hardest for the win finishing only 0"2 apart, with Belina 3rd. Sunday's rain affected the

race, yet Janouš proved unmatchable in heat 2 and 3, winning by a considerable margin. Janouš took also the win in the final scoreboard, ahead of Hájek and Belina. Vmmotor racing team driver Erik Písacka finished 4th.

Round 3 saw clear blue sky, with temperature over 30 degrees, and warm track. In **Bambini**, among the favourites were Korený, Javurek and Filip. Time practice went to Javurek.
